#### *Reviewing the Strategic Development Plan for Laborie 2002*

The workshop is organized as part of the review process for the Strategic Development Plan for Laborie under a project entitled Creating Sustainable Communities – Building Capacity for Adaptation to Climate Change and Related Issues.
